



The talk can cover a range of information from salt marsh ecology, conservation, commercial fishing and detailed information on all sorts of sea creatures. At the end of each talk the students get their hands wet and are encouraged to handle everything.

I will be bringing in live sea animals with salt water and some frozen animals. (Things may get a little wet.) You will need to provide a space for me to set up with access to an electrical outlet, two medium sized tables and someone to help me set up. Because of the salt water and the animals it is impossible to move the program during the day.



Each presentation lasts about 45 minutes. With a half-hour talk and approximately 15 minutes of hands on. It is imperative that the group size is kept under 30 students. This way all of the students will get a chance to "touch, feel and smell" everything without being crowded.
